With all the world is experiencing these days we are so glad to be a part of what is GOOD! We are supporting 100's of homeless, broken souls each week that have big needs. Lifesaving needs:

food for their hunger, water for their thirst, hygiene for their body, prayer & encouragement for their soul.

Q. How is 'hygiene' a lifesaving need you ask? A. Even homeless person desires to be clean. There is a stigma of shame that comes with a dirty body that can destroy a person's self-worth. I have had people pull away from me as I reach out to touch them. "You don't want to touch me," they say. "Yes, I do" I reply. Because a human touch can *make a difference* in the life of a broken man or women.

Human touch is also alive and thriving at Millie's House of Hope. F.y.i. at the time of this writing we have openings for 2 women. One lady will be teaching Sunday School at a local Church! She is 8 months into her recovery and alive in Christ as she continues to grow. Her heart to teach children has been recognized and we thank God for the Church allowing her work alongside their Sunday School team.

Duluth Harbor Mission will soon announce a new support group reaching out to Families of those with loved ones experiencing substance abuse. We will receive our resources through **THRIVE! Family Addiction Support**

Another new development for us is upgrading our 501(c)3 status which will allow us to serve homemade food instead of only processed food. I cannot express how happy this makes me personally. Even though pizza, and canned beef stew, and corn dogs are filling, homemade is healthier.

We will also be able to legally accept hotdishes from local churches ... lol. hint hint...

I thank you for your continued support and prayers as our staff and volunteers press on, anticipating and preparing for WINTER! YES! Mission's around the country are now beginning their outreach for their winter support. Winter support for Rescue Missions is vital for shelters located in extreme parts of the Country...and Northern Minnesota certainly falls into the category as being in one of those extreme locations.
