Grace and peace to you, people of God!

The New Year is always heralded by encouragements to change: "New Year: New You!" Marketers hoping to make money want to grow our dissatisfaction with ourselves and our lives. In the guise of a fresh start, we're greeted with a sense of dread meant to have us buying our way to a "better" life.

What would it look like for you to begin the new year with gratitude and contentment instead of dread? It takes some effort to set your own thoughts rather than allow media to create your narrative. In these final days of the year, write down those things that have brought joy, peace, and love into your life. What were the moments when you felt good? Create a practice of writing down a gratitude a day and setting them somewhere you can see them.

How can you accept what might come in the next year without trying to control what is outside of your control? The original sin is our human desire to be more than we are: to have control and power beyond what belongs to us. Not only does that hurt others, it also hurts us. Be intentional about the things within your control, doing what you can for your health and the good of the world. Scripture offers this encouragement when we become overwhelmed with the problems of the world, "be still and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10). God is working to heal the world, and one day will make all things well.

In our Lutheran tradition, we are only baptized once, but we live each day newly washed in God's grace. God forgives and restores us daily. "The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases, God's mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning" (Lamentations 3:22-23a). Whatever we want to leave behind in the last year can be left behind. That's as much true on January first as it is on June 11th. Every day, we live refreshed in God's grace.



Treasurer's Report/Finance Committee: Total receipts in October were \$35,795.51, with \$7774 for the general fund, \$26,994.01 from Grinnell Insurance for the roof replacement and \$1027.50 for donations to the Duluth Harbor Mission for hygiene supplies. Total expenses in October were \$\$7226.53, \$7036 from the General Fund and \$190.53 from Irving Youth Special Fund. The balance in the Special funds is \$46,490 and we have \$193.476 in our CD at EverBank.

Pastor's Report – The Proctor Ecumenical Thanksgiving service is Sunday Nov. 19th at 6:00pm at St. Rose. We will be Caroling again. Dec. 18th at 5:00 pm. Meet here at the church.

President's Report – There used to be microphones/transmitters for the hearing impaired. Is going to enlist a few people to look for them and to see if they are in working order.

Treasurer's Report Narrative for 11/30/23

Receipts for November were \$8,217 for the General Fund and \$12,159 for Special Funds, including \$10,752.28 received from Grinnell Insurance for the roof replacement, \$1116 for the Christmas Luncheon, Fundraising and sales of tickets, and \$290 to Memorials.

Expenses paid in November were \$7,625 for the General Fund and \$11,945, \$10,702 to Peak Roofing from Capital Improvements, \$1043 to Duluth Harbor Mission from that designated fund, \$100 to VLM from Irving Youth SF and \$100 to Deb V. for expenses related to the Christmas Luncheon.

That puts us under YTD budget for revenues by \$5,754 and under YTD budget for expenses by \$10,214, largely due to not paying for secretarial wages and related expenses for these past eleven months of the year.

The balance in special funds is \$46,704 and \$194,061 in our CD at Everbank (fka TIAA).
